### **HEC 02/2022 - REVIEW OF THE HIGHER EDUCATION LEGISLATION**

The Ministry of Education, Heritage and Arts (**MEHA**) with the Higher Education Commission (**Commission**), are seeking proposals from a suitably qualified individual(s), firm(s), or groups with expertise in law and legal systems and higher education to undertake a review of Fiji's higher education legislation (**Review**). The purpose of the review is to ensure that the higher education sector meets the requirements of Fiji's current and future needs and is therefore supplemented by the legislation.

**The MEHA and the Commission hereby is requesting for proposals for the Review of the Higher Education Legislation.**

We encourage suitably qualified individuals and/or firms, national, regional, or international organisations and/or entities with extensive experience in legislative reviews to submit proposals. Any proposal(s) that is submitted as a joint venture, proposal(s) must be submitted by the lead firm or lead partner and should identify each joint venture partners.
