**Grooming** - when someone (often an adult) befriends a child online and builds an emotional connection with future intentions of sexual abuse, sexual exploitation or trafficking

**Cyber stalking** - threatening behavior or unwanted advances directed at another person using the Internet and other forms of online and computer for example by sending threatening emails.

**Cyber predators**: are people who use the internet to lie about their personal detail to gain the trust of young people and exploit them for sexual and other purposes.
