<u>Punching</u> - to hit (someone) with a powerful punch, often so as to render unconscious. <u>Beating</u> - to hit a person repeatedly so as to cause painful injury.

Slapping - to strike (a person) sharply, as with the open hand or something flat.

Swearing - to use bad or vulgar language at someone.

<u>Disrespectful</u> - showing a lack of respect or courtesy/impolite.

<u>Name calling</u> - (teasing/belittling) using abusive language or insult at anyone.

Negative Peer Pressure – students influence other student to do bad things.

<u>Cyber bullying</u> – involves the use of information and communication technologies such as e-mail, text messages, instant messages, and web sites to engage in the bullying of other individuals or groups of people.

Sexting - the action or practice of sending sexually explicit photographs or messages via mobile phone.

<u>Pornography</u>- Sexually explicit writing, images, video, or other material whose primary purpose is to cause sexual arousal.

<u>Cyber Grooming</u> - when someone (often an adult) befriends a child online and builds an emotional connection with future intentions of sexual abuse, sexual exploitation or trafficking.

<u>Cyber stalking</u> - threatening behavior or unwanted advances directed at another person using the Internet and other forms of online and computer for example by sending threatening emails.

<u>Cyber predators</u>: are people who use the internet to lie about their personal detail to gain the trust of young people and exploit them for sexual and other purposes.

Revenge porn: revealing or sexually explicit images or video of a person posted on internet typically by former sexual partners without the consent of the subject to cause embarrassment and distress.

<u>Fake Account</u>: is the process of creating accounts using fake or stolen identity information.
