



PUBLIC CONSULTATIONS – REVIEW OF THE EDUCATION ACT 1966

The Ministry of Education and the Fiji Law Reform Commission with the support of UNICEF and the Fiji Programs Support Platform will hold public consultations from **7 May to 14 June 2025** for the review of the Education Act 1966 and related laws. The review aims to modernize its provisions and improve the education system. This review will focus on key areas including curriculum relevance, teacher development, school governance, and enhanced facilities.
